We recognise that waste plastics pose a threat globally to the environment.

Within our Plastic Policy we commit to minimising our use of plastics and reducing the environmental impact of waste plastics.

Marsh Fuels is responsible for this policy. All of Marsh Fuel's employees share responsibility for its delivery.

To minimise our use of plastics we shall ...

- Measure and audit our use of single-use plastics and continually look for reduction opportunities.
- Develop an assessment of the environmental impact of plastics we buy and use to inform the purchaser of goods and services.
- Where the use of plastics is unavoidable, we will use recycled plastics where practicable.
- Where possible, we will aim to buy only those plastic products that can be easily reused or recycled.
- Work with our supply chain to develop capability and capacity for recycling plastics waste.
- Promote 'Unflushables' awareness within the office. Ban flushable plastic waste, such as wet wipes and cotton buds.
- Identify resources we can re-use or find environmentally friendly alternatives, regardless of increased cost if necessary.
- Internally promote behaviours that reduce reliance on plastics, particularly encouraging the use of tap water over bottled water and the reduction of plastic packaging waste.
- Actively look to educate customers to recycle our packaging and offer further information where required.
- Support and encourage employee and community initiatives to remove plastic waste and litter from the environment.
